

BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

The celebration of birthdays is a wonderful way to honor a child's life and accomplishments. The celebration is done during circle. A candle is lit and the child walks around the sun while the life story is read. Each walk around the sun depicts one year of the child's life. This is followed by the child making a secret wish and blowing the candle out. (Due to the current pandemic, we use a flameless candle and pretend to blow it out).

Kindly prepare a collage of your child's pictures from each year of their life. You can get as creative as you like. Please let your child participate in selecting pictures and writing his/her life story. The child's story will be read during the celebration. You may prepare your child's story using the following format:
